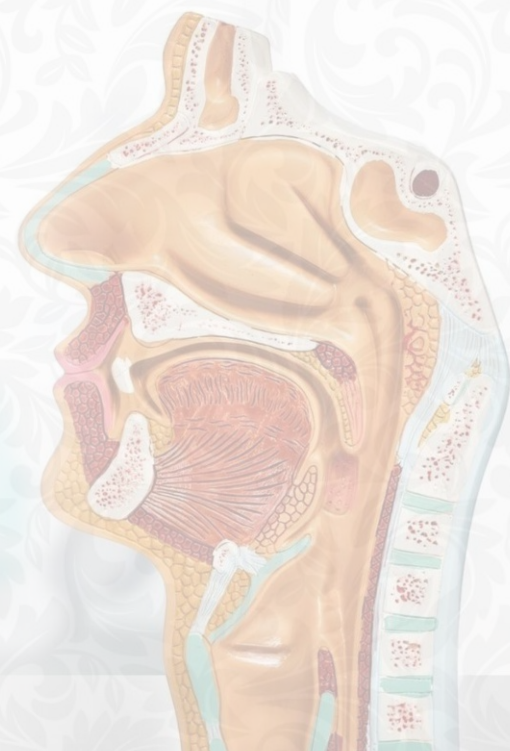
Beyond the academic sessions, the conference will also offer excellent opportunities for networking & collaboration among professionals dedicated to improving patient care and advancing medical excellence.
